The styling is pure Thunderbird, dynamic and graceful. An eloquent statement of Ford design leadership in this age of aerodynamic cars.


And the interior is exceptionally appointed and highly ergonomic in every detail. An environment designed expressly for the serious driver.

DRIVER CONTROL

There's a special attribute all true driver's cars, past and present, have in common: The focus of interior design is on the driver.

In much the same way as a car's performance depends on engineering quality and precision, a driver's performance at the wheel depends on the car's ergonomic design excellence.



With this understanding, Ford designers crafted the Thunderbird's ergonomic interior with their sights on the goal that all designers strive for in a genuine driver's car: Driver control.

How easily and naturally you interact with the car is of prime importance in the total ergonomic equation. In Thunderbird, behind every detail of design you sense by sight or touch is a careful understanding of how you function, both mentally

and physically, as the driver. The objective of driver ergonomics is to enable you to devote as much attention as possible to controlling the car.

You'll find the most important controls positioned within close reach and identifiable quickly by touch, and the instruments located and colored so that they are easy to read at a glance.

The steering wheel (a unique design in each model) provides an unobstructed view of the instrument cluster as well as a firm grip (leather-wrapped in LX; sport soft-feel in Super Coupe).

The seating is designed for firm and supportive comfort. At right is the Super Coupe interior, whose articulated sport seats with power-adjustable lumbar support and seat-back bolster complement the car's high-performance capability.

THUNDERBIRD LX



The Thunderbird would be a fine car to own even if it were not as luxuriously equipped as it is. Because important as personal appointments are in this class of car, more significant still is quality of design and engineering.

In striving to be the best in overall design quality, we employ a "Best-in-Class" philosophy, the principles of which guided the Thunderbird's

modern design. In areas ranging from vehicle dynamics and mechanical operation to comfort and aesthetics, we evaluated more than 350 Thunderbird features against the likes of the Mercedes 190E and BMW 6-Series.

Our goal was to be "Best-in-Class" in as many features as possible or necessary, with our sights always on the ultimate customer benefit of each.

We compared, for example, Thunderbird's body joints for structural integrity against those of a variety of import and domestic cars. So when you experience Thunderbird's quiet comfort and solid feel over the road, what you're experiencing is a result of our "Best-in-Class" approach to design.

While for us it isn't the easiest and least costly approach, for you it certainly is the best.

COMFORT

A luxurious 5-passenger driver's car. This is the essence of Ford Thunderbird. It's a personal car for those who truly enjoy driving. But it's also for those who appreciate just as well the enjoyment of sitting back and riding along as a passenger.

Today's Thunderbird, just as its heralded predecessors did, combines in a special way attributes of sportiness and elegance.

Between the well-designed and handsomely upholstered front bucket seats is a full-length

Ford Thunderbird is the result of our designers' goal to create a personal car that's as much a pleasure to ride in as it is to drive.

The Thunderbird environment provides ample room for five adult passengers. The seats, front and rear, are firm and supportive — the result of thousands of miles of testing and evaluation.

Air conditioning is standard. Power windows, front seat-back recliners, AM/FM stereo/cassette, and leather-wrapped wheel, too. And there are luxury items like 6-way power seat adjustment (driver-side included, passenger-side optional).

And with Thunderbird's high structural strength, extensive sound insulation, and 4-wheel independent suspension with gas-pressurized shock absorbers, you have what is perhaps the finest feature of all: Smooth ride comfort.

RIDE AND HANDLING

Finely balanced ride and handling. It's one of the attributes that make the Thunderbird a complete personal car for those who really love to drive.

Thunderbird's advanced 4-wheel independent suspension, equipped with components such as nitrogen gas-pressurized shock absorbers and variable-rate coil springs, is engineered to deliver not only a smooth ride but tight handling as well.

Precise handling as well as smooth ride quality: Both are yours to enjoy in the Thunderbird tradition of luxury-sport motoring.

The handling part of the equation is further enhanced by a stabilizer bar up front and at the rear. Also, the suspension incorporates a rear toe-control link similar to those found on European performance cars. It's designed to control a wheel's direction as the suspension moves up and down, especially during hard acceleration, cornering and braking.

Sophisticated, too, is the variable power-assist "speed-sensitive" steering. Responding to electronic speed sensors located at the wheels, this state-of-the-art, computer-controlled system provides more power assist at low speeds (when you're cornering or parking, for example) and progressively reduces power assist as rpm increase for a firmer steering feel at cruising speeds.



Super Coupe's body-contoured front articulated sport seats are designed to help hold you in place when you're cornering. They include power-

With its special suspension package, the Thunderbird Super Coupe takes you into the world of high-performance handling.


This package consists of 16-inch P225 Z-rated performance tires, a 1.10"-diameter solid front stabilizer bar and a 0.90"-diameter solid rear stabilizer bar, higher-rate coil springs, plus higher-rate front suspension lower arm pivot bushings.

Included as well is the automatic ride control suspension. Its microprocessor monitors signals from speed, brake pressure, steering and acceleration sensors, then automatically adjusts the shock absorber damping with split-second


precision to suit the driving situation. Damping is "normal" for a smooth ride or "firm" when extra handling is required (the "firm" mode may also be selected manually).

Yet another high-tech system standard in the Super Coupe is 4-wheel disc anti-lock braking.

adjustable lumbar and side bolster supports for comfort and control. And they can be adjusted to a wide range of positions to suit individual needs.



The 4-wheel anti-lock brake system (ABS), computer-controlled, prevents the wheels from locking up in a hard braking situation by applying and releasing the brakes at a rate of speed far exceeding that of human capability — up to 10 times per second. It's much like a professional driver who skillfully "pumps" the brakes, only much faster.



ABS is standard on Thunderbird Super Coupe and optional on Thunderbird LX.



POWER

Thunderbird gives you the power to choose the kind of performance that matches your driving style. The Thunderbird LX offers a 3.8-liter V-6 standard or a 5.0-liter HO V-8 option. Under the Super Coupe's hood is a supercharged V-6.

The 3.8-liter V-6 is smooth and responsive. Its state-of-the-art sequential electronic fuel-injection (SEFI) system releases fuel efficiently

Choose a normally aspirated V-6, a supercharged V6, or a muscular V-8. Thunderbird is as serious as you are about performance. and precisely to each cylinder in "sequence" with the engine's spark

firing order. Fuel metering


operations governed by the sophisticated EEC-IV computer, which constantly fine-tunes the engine to the requirements of the moment.

The 5.0-liter HO (high-output) V-8 is also equipped with sequential electronic fuel injection. It puts out 200 horsepower (SAE net) @ 4,000 rpm and 275 lbs./ft. of torque @ 3,000 rpm.


The 3.8-liter SEFI supercharged V-6 gives you the best of both worlds: 6-cylinder fuel economy at constant speeds (EPA estimates were unavailable at press time) and muscular V-8 power on demand when the supercharger kicks in.

Mechanically driven, the supercharger works across a broad range of engine rpm. Response is quick even at a standing start, without the momentary "lag" associated with turbocharging.

The 3.8-liter SCV-6 is the most powerful supercharged production engine in America.



Super Coupe's roots-type supercharger: The finely fitted rotors spin very close to each other and to the inside of the housing, pulling air inside and forcing it into the induction system. Super Coupe generates 210 hp (SAE net) @ 4,000 rpm and 315 lbs./ft. of torque @ 2,800 rpm.



Super Coupe's supercharged engine employs a device called an intercooler. Located between the supercharger and the combustion chamber, the intercooler lowers the temperature of the air passing through it, thereby increasing its density and increasing horsepower even more.

A split fold-down rear seat back is included with optional leather seating surfaces in Super Coupe. It allows access to the trunk from inside the car and permits longer cargo like skis or golf clubs.

The convenient automatic day/night rearview mirror is part of the optional autolamp group.



For added security, Thunderbird offers a new optional remote keyless entry system.
