

Roomy, quiet 2-door Ford SuperCab Pickups are available in Custom, Ranger and Ranger XLT luxury levels. The standard front seat with seven inches of foam padding provides stretch-out room for three big adults. And the seat design allows easy access to the rear compartment. Large 15 x 15-inch rear side windows are also standard. Flip-open windows optional.



Famous Twin-I-Beam independent front suspension is an exclusive Ford feature offering a smooth ride and superb handling—plus strength and durability. Double-wall quarter panels bolster cab strength. Sturdy frame siderails up to 8 inches deep. And SuperCab pick-ups come with 6¾ or 8-ft. Styleside box (either fits in a standard garage).
