








## 1971 Monaco. How the man who's arrived arrives.




wheelbase for excellent maneuverability and parking ease, which pleases the lady of the house. If you'd like a little extra luxury, the Crestwood has a simulated wood-grained exterior and deluxe interior trim. New on the 1971 Coronet station wagons is the electric Auto-Lock. This feature makes it hard to unlatch the Dual Action tailgate from the inside when the ignition is on. For safety reasons, the door can be opened when the ignition is on, but the effort is greater.

Standard equipment on Polara and Monaco wagons are the Dual Action tailgate and the aerodynamic rear window cleaning vane. Comfort and convenience options at extra cost include Chrysler Corporation's exclusive air conditioning that dispenses cool air in the roomy rear compartment for added passenger comfort; adjustable roof rack; a Trailer-Towing Package; and more powerful engines. 




#### NEW TORSION-QUIET RIDE

It retains all the fine handling characteristics of these luxury cars and further reduces road and engine noise in the passenger compartment. Noise reduction is achieved by using a new type of rubber isolator in a number of key suspension locations: at the front, in the rear, and along the steering gear.
