The idea behind turbocharging is simple: increase engine power output signifi-cantly at higher engine rpm. This is done by recycling the engine's exhaust heat energy and using it to spin a turbine. The turbine, in turn, drives a compressor located in the engine's intake system.

The compressor forces more air/fuel mixture into the combustion chamber at a much higher engine rpm than is possible in a nonturbocharged or "normally aspirated" engine. The more throttle you give a turbocharged engine, the faster the turbine spins and the further the engine power output increases.


