





For extra passenger-driver comfort, you can order a 60/40 divided front seat. The seating itself, front and rear, is up to six inches of contoured foam. There is a soft-padded front center armrest in the hard-tops and the convertible. Rich fabrics in a wide range of colors are yours to choose from. And a distinctive Royale touch is the attractive color-coordinated vinyl molding which accents each side.
