






## INTERIOR

## SECURITY

It makes for an extremely rigid unibody, consisting of front and rear crumple zones, side-impact door beams, floor crossmembers, and high-rigidity side sills. Simply put, it's an incredibly tough nut to crack. And when you factor in the Galant's available driver and front passenger side air bags\* you'll feel safe no matter what part of town you're driving through.

The Galant's engineers realize, however, that the best safety feature is one that never has to be used. That's why the Galant comes with rack-and-pinion steering, a fully independent suspension, available traction control, and 4-wheel anti-lock disc brakes. And if you think all this maneuverability will make it hard to keep a child's seat secure in the Galant, the LATCH system will have you thinking again. The fact is, every inch of the Galant has been designed to help keep you, your mate, and anything else the family tree drops on you, safely driving for a long, long time.






