





Traction Control - To improve traction on loose or slippery surfaces, Freestyle's available Traction Control uses engine and/or brake controls to reduce wheel spin on front-wheeldrive models. The system senses any loss of traction and steps in to help you regain grip. On Freestyle AWD models, Traction Control makes a proven system even better by allowing AWD to direct torque side to side on each axle. Even if only one wheel has traction, AWD can direct most of the torque there to maintain forward motion.

# > RAISING THE SAFETY BAR

# The Benefits Of SPACE

SPACE Architecture<sup>TM</sup> — Freestyle's advanced Side Protection And Cabin Enhancement Architecture employs a hydroformed cross-car beam that runs between the door frames, strengthening each bodyside and providing a raised mounting point for the front seats. In a side-impact collision, a bend in the beam's middle serves as a trigger point for deformation, helping to divert crash forces to underneath the seats and away from occupants.

# O A Crash Course In Force Management

Frame and Chassis Structure — A tripod design in Freestyle's front structure channels frontal crash forces upward and downward into a high-strength-steel "ring of protection" that surrounds the passenger compartment. On AWD models, even the patent-pending driveshaft is collapsible, allowing it to absorb some of the crash energy of a frontal impact in a controlled manner. Side-impact door beams extend across the 2 strongest areas of the door frame, helping to protect against passenger-compartment intrusion in certain side-impact collisions. In the rear, structural elements meet a more stringent federal crash standard years before it takes effect.



# > SAFETY & SECURITY INNOVATION

The all-new Ford Freestyle redefines protection. For example, all seating positions receive 3-point safety belts and adjustable head restraints. Pretensioners tighten 1st-row safety belts within milliseconds of an impact and, as the crash progresses, load-limiting retractors "pay out" the belts to reduce peak forces on occupants and help increase protection. Through advanced computer-optimization programs, our engineers evaluated over 50,000 crash simulations to reach the ideal settings for these safety restraints.


