

Here are the newest wagons from Mercury, with the most magnificent collection of better station wagon ideas in '72.

MX and Montego MX Villager. Both have a longer 118.0" wheelbase and wider stance. Cargo space is big enough to carry a 4' x 8' plywood panel flat with the tailgate down. Both are loaded with features. There's a unique three-way tailgate that swings down for long loads and swings open for people and luggage. Standard features include an economical 250 cu. in. "Six" engine, 3-speed manual transmission, power front disc brakes, all-vinyl interiors and deep loop pile carpeting. The MX Villager also features "Yacht Deck" panelling on body sides and tailgate.

Moving up in size, there are two Meteor wagons—the Rideau 500 and the Montcalm. The styling is elegant; the interior luxurious. There's extra smooth riding on a 121 inch wheelbase. The cargo area has 96.2 cubic feet of space. A unique three-way tailgate makes for especially easy loading and entry. There's

also an additional 9.1 cubic feet of space in a lockable storage compartment under the load area floor. Power steering, 3-speed Select-Shift automatic transmission, forced air ventilation system and 351-2V cubic inch V-8 are all standard. 
