



Carpeting is deep loop-pile, selected and woven to our specifications. It covers layers of sound insulating pads on the floor. So you not only enjoy luxurious carpeting, you also enjoy restful quiet. Brougham standard interiors are available in blue, green, parchment, black, gold, red and white in all-vinyl. Of course, the same considerate attention is paid other interior features, both standard and optional.



INTERIORS AND FEATURES

The capacity of the 1975 Town & Country to satisfy is as large as its capacity for carrying. And that is sizeable. It can carry a sheet of 4' x 8' paneling flat, with the tailgate closed! Even with the front seats at the most rearward position!

The standard interior seating is, if you desire, an all-vinyl 50/50 divided bench seat, with individually adjustable seats, folding dual center armrests and passenger side recliner. Colors are blue, green, parchment, black, gold, and chestnut.

The same type of seat is available in cloth-andvinyl as a "no charge" option. Colors: gold, or parchment. Third seat is all-vinyl.

Loop-pile carpeting, is standard throughout, including the entire cargo area floor, on both the 2-seat model and 3-seat model.

The Town & Country's power to please is demonstrated in other areas.

Steel-belted radial tires, front sway bar, heavyduty shock absorbers (front and rear), computerselected springs (rear), rear fender skirts and roof air deflector are all standard.

You'll also appreciate these additional standard features: power steering, power front disc brakes, power Auto-Lock which locks the 3-way tailgate when the ignition is on, power tailgate window, 440 CID V-8 engine, (a smaller 400 CID V-8 is optional), and new high speed 1.8 hp starting motor.




Deep, rich-looking loop-pile carpeting, as durable as it is luxurious, is standard throughout on both cars.







Helps increase spark plug life to about 30,000 miles on engines operated on unleaded gas Has no points or condenser to replace.

Electronic voltage regulator:

Contributes to longer battery life when compared to conventional regulators.

Unibody construction:

Body panels and structural members on all Chryslers are fused into one unit by more than 4,000 tough




Torsion-bar suspension:

7-step dip-and-spray process:

To prevent rust, Chrysler's bodies are cleaned, coated, sprayed (with two coats of primer), baked sanded, painted (with two coats of enamel containing the same tough material used to protect kitchen floors . . . acrylic), and finally baked again.

Some of our Newest Chrysler Engineering Features.

The following engineering features, though less well-known than, for example, our Electronic Ignition System, are meant to add to the convenience, reliability and operating economy one can expect of our Chryslers.

For Convenience:

Full volume foam seats.

Foam padding is attached directly to the seat frame, eliminating the need for spring elements. Used on Town & Country second-seat backs and third-seat seats and backs.

Modular instrument panels.

An improved approach to panel design allows all components (gauges, switches, indicators, heater controls) to be removed from the front, rather than the back, of the panel.

 Remote-control outside mirror—right side.
 Control lever is located just to the right of heater controls for easy driver access. Optional on all Chryslers.

Larger, molded dash panel liners.

To help lessen the chances of road noise reaching the Chrysler passenger compartment, our new liner covers more than 3 times the area than our previous liners.

· Built-in step at the tailgate.

By using an extruded aluminum panel between the rear bumper and body, full-size wagons have a built-in step for entering the rear. It also pivots out of the way when the bumper is deflected.

Revised 3-way tailgate.

Due to a newly engineered hinging system, the gate when dropped down, is nearly level with the cargo floor for easier loading.

External noise reduced 60% from 1974.
 Through the use of exhaust system resonators, mufflers with more internal baffles and high frequency chambers, larger diameter tail pipes, and either radiator flex fans or thermal fan drives, all help lower the sound level of our 1975 cars.

8-stream wiper mounted windshield washers.
 Each washer puts 4 streams of fluid over its windshield area instead of 1 spray. It's a design you'll appreciate most when you need it most.

Optional manual vent window (4-door models).
 It is much easier to seal against wind noise and water leaks because of its unique pivoting.

For Operating Economy:

· Optional Fuel Pacer System.

It constantly monitors the intake manifold vacuum. When the mixture is "fuel-rich", it alerts the driver with an amber light in the left fender-mounted turn signal. You are using gas more economically when the amber light is off.

Lower axle ratios.

With the standard engine for Newport and Newport Custom and the optional engine for New Yorker Brougham and Town & Country, a lower axle ratio is available. As a rule, the lower the axle ratio, the better the fuel economy.

Light touch accelerator pedal.
 Both standard and optional engines have dual concentric throttle return spring—in addition to a torsion spring—for extra safety.

 Extension of oil change interval.
 The recommended oil change interval for all Chryslers has been extended from 3 months/4,000 miles to 6 months/5,000 miles.

Extension of spark plug replacement interval.

The recommended spark plug replacement interval for Newport and Newport Custom engines operating on unleaded fuels has been increased from 18,000 miles to 30,000 miles.

 Phase II Electronic Ignition System.
 Standard with all New Yorker Brougham and Town & Country, it combines our Electronic Ignition System with long-life spark plugs and long-life battery.

For Reliability:

Long-life spark plugs

These new spark plugs have a platinum alloy center electrode with chromium-plated surface. They are standard with the 440 CID engine in New Yorker Brougham and Town & Country.

Long-life battery.

Standard on New Yorker Brougham and Town & Country, this 500 amp battery performs very well under extreme conditions—hot or cold.

· Battery heat shield.

An insulated cover which slips over the battery, but allows outside cooling air to flow around it. When the engine is idling in city traffic, this cover can reduce battery temperature rise by as much as 37% which helps prolong battery life. Standard on all Chryslers.

New Voltage Control System.

Protects battery from over-charging (the main factor for a battery dying before its time), reduces radio fade and headlight flare, increases air conditioning air flow when the engine is idling, and prolongs the life of all light bulbs.


9½ inch rear axle.

Standard on all Chryslers, this design reduces the chances of lubricant leaks or the entrance of water.

Strong door latches.

Standard on all Chryslers, these door latches are smaller in size but stronger than previous latches.
