They add up to extra years of low-cost, reliable transportation-and help add to resale value when the time comes to trade. Here are basic reasons why Dodge pickups give people what they want and need.

FRONT AND REAR SHOCK ABSORBERS, STANDARD. They add to EASY-OFF TAILGATE. It can be smooth performance that cuts down removed quickly without tools. on wear. "Front only" on D300 models. 
