More than 3000 welds fuse the body and structural members into one strong, solid structure.

#### Impact-Absorbing Bumper System.

Gives you solid protection against minor damage, both front and rear, with hydraulic energy-absorbing units.

#### Front Disc Brakes.

Standard on all Volaré models, for smooth, sure stopping. Power front disc brakes are standard on all wagons and are a required option with 8-cylinder engines or with air conditioning.

#### Optional 4-Speed Manual Overdrive Transmission.

An important highway feature available with 225 Slant Six, 225 Super Six, or 318 V-8 engines.

#### TorqueFlite Automatic Transmission.

Rugged and reliable! Completely maintenance-free under normal driving conditions. No band adjustments, no fluid or filter replacement recommended under normal driving conditions.

#### Lock-Up Torque Converter.

The new lock-up torque converter provides direct mechanical linkage between the engine and the rear axle when the automatic transmission shifts into drive, resulting in better gas mileage, cooler transmission temperature, and lower engine speed. (Standard with 225 CID 6 on coupe and sedan and 318 and 360 CID 2-bbl. V-8s in 49 states. Standard on 318 CID V-8 4-bbl. in California. Not available at high altitudes or with H.D. engine.)

#### 7-Step Rust and Corrosion Protection.

The future stays bright with Chrysler-built cars. Every car body is thoroughly cleaned and coated with special chemicals in a 7-step dip-and-spray process to combat corrosion. Then two coats of tough epoxy primer are applied, baked and sanded. Finally, three coats of acrylic enamel are baked to a glossy, lasting luster.

### Long Oil Change Interval.

Under normal driving conditions, your 1978 Volaré has an oil change interval of 7500 miles or six months of driving. It's another example of how Chrysler engineering is striving to reduce maintenance on its cars.

## Isolated Transverse Suspension System.

A ride that's as smooth and comfortable as the ride in larger cars! Volare's Isolated Transverse Suspension System utilizes a cross-member, which sits just under the engine, torsion bars, and a two-fold system of rubber mountings which isolate the Unibody from road noise and vibration. First, two transversely mounted torsion bars, by their twisting motion, absorb major shocks from bumps. These bars are isolated from the cross-member by rubber bushings. Secondly, the cross-member itself is isolated from the Unibody by four rubber cushions which provide a secondary absorption system. Thus, the action of the torsion bars and two sets of rubber isolators smothers shocks and road vibrations. This system gives you a ride that's as smooth and comfortable as the ride in some larger cars.

#### Isolated Semi-Elliptic Rear Springs.

Isolated from the rear axle by rubber spring-seat Iso-clamps and from the body by oval front bushings, as in our full-size cars. Helps cushion Volare's ride.

#### Volaré Gets It Together With A 2-bbl. Version Of The 225 Slant Six Engine. It's Called The "Super Six."

One of the most popular engines Chrysler offers is the 225 1-barrel Slant Six. There's also a 2-barrel version—the optional 225 2-bbl. Super Six—with ten more horsepower to give you peppy performance. (Standard on Wagons.) For those who prefer V-8 performance, there's the ever-popular 318 V-8. Or choose the optional 360 2-bbl. or 360 4-bbl.—with Electronic Lean Burn System. (All V-8s are now equipped with Electronic Lean Burn except the 360 4-bbl. in California and high altitudes.)

#### Sound Insulation and "Quiet" Systems.

In addition to the low noise levels achieved through Volare's new fully isolated suspension, the optional deluxe sound insulation system has extensive acoustical materials applied wherever wind noise or vibration can enter the passenger compartment.






