The St. Regis is exceptional in another way: standard







Feelings.



Everything about the St. Regis was designed to bring about feelings. Warm, wonderful feelings.

The individually adjustable 60/40 seats with folding center armrest and passenger-side recliner are of soft Saxony and Whittier cloth on the standard offering (shown at right) and plush Oxford vinyl on the two optional selections.

The ride is as smooth and as quiet as that of any car we



have ever built. More engineering ingenuity here. Front torsion-bar suspension and a redesigned rear leaf-spring suspension geometry. And generous application of sound-reducing materials throughout its Unibody.

Worthy of note, too, are the new optional semi-automatic and manual air conditioning systems of 26% greater capacity, and quieter performance, than last year's.

The St. Regis is also obliging in little ways. Small touches that make things easier for you. The steering column multi-function control switch with headlamp dimmer, turn signal and windshield washer/wiper controls conveniently located on the turn-signal lever. A courtesy light under the instrument panel. And soothing chimes to replace buzzers.
