REAR SUSPENSION—Semi-elliptic springs with grooved and tapered leaves. Metal spring covers on Royal and Windsor rear springs. Wax-impregnated liners in Saratoga, New Yorker and Town and Country leaves. Hydra-Lizer two-way direct-acting shock absorbers. FRAME—Double-channel, welded box type, four cross-members for extra rigidity.

STEERING—Center-arm steering system with equallength tie rods and 3-tooth worm and roller steering gear.

BRAKES—Chrysler Safe-Guard hydraulic, 12-in. diameter internal expanding, with Cyclebonded brake linings for longer life.
