

For 1969, Monaco is completely new—from grille to wraparound taillights. From concealed windshield wipers to a new rear deck design. From curved window glass on the sides to an exclusive new option called Super-Lite. Monaco is longer, lower—and more comfortable than ever.

This is evident the moment you slip behind the wheel. The seat is pleated, foam-padded, and finished in expensive fabrics and vinyls. The carpeting is exceptionally rich, deep pile, and offered in six colors. Airtemp's automatic temperature control air conditioner (optional) lets you relax in your own preferred climate. Optional Dodge 8-track stereo with dual rear speakers is also available.

1969 Monaco. Dodge is turning up the luxury as well as the Fever . . . now.






1969 MONACO: IT DOESN'T GET BY ON LOOKS ALONE.

Monaco's all-new look may, at first, cause you to ignore one of its other attributes—namely, that this is a car made to drive. Every Monaco, for example, comes with a standard 383-cubic-inch V8 engine. As well as superb road-clinging torsion-bar suspension.

This year, Monaco's new instrument panel features aircraft-type rocker switches. And all Monaco hardtops and sedans come with cornering lights that enable you to see in the direction you intend to turn. For options, Monaco offers the exciting new Super-Lite (discussed in detail on page 6), a tilt steering wheel, and a powerful 440-cubic-inch Magnum V8, just for starters.

YOUR DODGE DEALER will be happy to show you many of Monaco's new and unique features for 1969. For example, here you see the standard Monaco all-vinyl interior, with fold-down center armrest, for hardtops and wagons (Monaco sedans have a cloth-and-vinyl interior). A new Monaco Brougham interior, optional on sedans and 4-door hardtops, has a split bench front seat with passenger-side recliner (this type of seat is also optional on Monaco station wagons). The Monaco 500 interior, optional on 2-door hardtops, has front bucket seats with choice of center console or center front seat with fold-down armrest. The cornering light is standard on all Monaco models, except for station wagons, where it is optional. Vinyl roof covering is optional for sedans and hardtops. The exclusive new Dodge Super-Lite, shown mounted in the grille, is a new Monaco option.



INTRODUCING SUPER-LITE, FOR TRIPS, THE LIGHT FANTASTIC.

How many times have you driven on turnpikes at night and had to blink your bright beam on and off to keep from blinding oncoming drivers? We did something about that. We developed Dodge Super-Lite-a special high-intensity quartz-iodide lamp, coupled to precision optics and a unique light-pattern mask. No other car in the world has anything like it. Super-Lite projects a concentrated light beam almost as far ahead as your "brights"-but it doesn't get in the eyes of the oncoming drivers or in the mirror of the car ahead of you. (You can still use the brights, if you want. But now we give you a choice. Your left foot will appreciate it.) Please note: Our little diagram tells part of the Super-Lite story. A Trailer-Towing Package for Dodge Monaco models is required for towing trailers with a loaded gross weight of 2,500 lbs. and not exceeding 5,500 lbs. A frame-type loadequalizing hitch is required for trailers having a loaded tongue-weight of 250 lbs. (Hitch not supplied by Dodge.) Basic equipment includes: maximum cooling system with high-capacity radiator. Seven-blade fan. Fan shroud and hood seal. Heavy-duty performance axle, 3.23 ratio. Heavy-duty suspension, front and rear, with link-type sway bar and high-control shock absorbers. Special, 11"-diameter, heavy-duty brakes (manually adjustable). Heavy-duty turn signal flasher. Heavy-duty stoplight switch. Wide-rim

6-JJ wheels (6.5-JJ on wagons). The following extra-cost equipment is also required: Torqueflite automatic transmission. 8.55 x 15 tires (except station wagons); 9.15 x 15 tires on wagons. Recommended, additional optional equipment for trailer towing: Sure Grip differential. High-output, 46-amp alternator. Heavy-duty 70-amp-hr battery with rubber separators and battery heat shield. Power brakes. Front disc brakes. Power steering. Air conditioning. High-performance engines like the optional 383 (4-bbl.) V8 or 440 Magnum. Automatic speed control.

MONACO COMFORT AND CONVENIENCE OPTIONS

Monaco Airtemp air conditioning is available several ways. A special automatic temperature control option lets you dial the interior temperature desired, and this temperature will be maintained regardless of outside weather. You can order any Dodge Monaco model with regular air conditioning or with air conditioning plus automatic temperature control. The Monaco two-door hardtop, with air conditioning, has ventless side windows. In addition, for Monaco station wagens, you have the option of selecting dual air conditioning or dual air conditioning with automatic temperature control. Super-Life, a Dodge exclusive feature Rear window defogger (hardtops and sedan) Four radio options are offered on "69 Monaco models:

DIMENSIONS

(These are 1969 Monaco 4-door-sedan dimensions. Other body styles may vary in some degree.)
Wheelbase, 122". Track, front/rear, 62.1"/60.7".
Overall length, 220.8". Overall width, 79.3".

SUSPENSION

All Monaco models have torsion bars and ball joints in front, asymmetrical leaf springs in the rear, and Oriflow shock absorbers at each wheel. The entire suspension is rubber-isolated. A link-type sway bar is standard equipment.

BRAKES

Hydraulic, servo-contact, self-energizing, selfadjusting. Bonded linings. Dual Braking System. Parking brake is foot-pedal-operated, with hand-released lever, mechanically actuating shoes on each rear wheel. Master cylinder/parking brake warning light is standard on all models.

TIRES

All Monaco models (except wagons)......8.25 x 15 (5.5JJ wheels). Monaco station wagons....8.85 x 15 (6.0JJ wheels).

ELECTRICAL SYSTEM

Battery: 12-volt, 6-cell, 59-amp-hr, standard with 383-cu.-in. engines. 70-amp-hr, standard with 440-cu.-in. engines and optional with other engines. Alternator: 37-amp, standard. (46-amp, standard with Airtemp air conditioning and optional on Monaco models not so equipped.)

1969 MONACO STANDARD FEATURES

There is no such thing as a stripped-down version of this car.

REAR AXLE RATIOS

A number of rear axle ratios are offered with each Monaco engine and transmission team. Standard ratios have been carefully chosen to provide a balance of performance and economy. However, for more specialized applications, your Dodge Dealer can order your Monaco delivered with a more suitable ratio, at extra cost.

ENGINES

A 383-cu.-in. 2-bbl. V8 (uses regular fuel) is standard in all Monaco models. A 383 4-bbl. and a 440-cu.-in. 4-bbl. are optional for all models. The 440 V8 comes as the "440 Magnum V8" (375 hp @ 4600 rpm) for all models, except station wagons. Another version of the 440 V8 4-bbl. (350 hp @ 4400 rpm) is offered for Monaco station wagons.

TRANSMISSIONS

Two transmissions are offered for all Monaco models. The three-speed manual with column-mounted shift is standard, but available only with the 383 2-bbl. V8. The three-speed TorqueFlite automatic transmission is optional with all V8 engines.

The optional three-speed TorqueFlite automatic, when used with the optional Monaco 500 package equipped with center console, has the selector console-mounted.
