







and all-day turnpike hauling in stride. Typical Olds features that promote improved engine life are positive valve rotators. They help maintain excellent valve seating even under peak performance demands. A new "flex-head" intake valve also offers improved valve train efficiency, and engine durability. All Rocket

V-8s are responsive performers on no-lead, low-lead fuel, with lower emissions and long life for spark plugs, exhaust system and other components.




Olds added performance axles also provide proper ratios for trailer towing requirements. A higher ratio delivers more torque to the rear wheels, a lower ratio improves fuel economy. Rocket V-8 engines develop high torque at relatively low speeds, so that very high axle ratios are not needed. Recommended or required axle ratio specifications are listed on Equipment and Models chart.

Break-in procedures for your new Oldsmobile are spelled out in detail in your Owner's Manual. In addition, it is recommended that your new Olds be driven at least 500 miles before trailer towing. If

towing is necessary during this period, avoid speeds over 50 mph, and full throttle starts. Vehicle maintenance is required more frequently when using the car for trailer towing.

TRAILERING TIP: Drive with care. On long or steep grades, use transmission low range to assist braking . . . as outlined in the Transmission section of the Oldsmobile Owner's Manual.







Engines

Rocket V-8 engines. In addition to standard engines, more responsive Rocket V-8s are



Rocket 350 V-8, 4-bbl. (L34) required on Omega for light-weight trailer towing. This is the standard engine on Cutlass, Cutlass S, Cutlass Supreme and Vista-Cruiser models. Available on Delta 88s.

Rocket 455 V-8, 4-bbl. (L74) standard engine on Custom Cruiser and Ninety-Eight models. Available for Delta 88 models.

Rocket 455 V-8, 4-bbl. (L75) available on Cutlass, Cutlass S, Cutlass Supreme and Vista-Cruiser. Rocket 455 V-8, 4-bbl. (L78) with dual exhaust, standard engine on Toronado.

Added Performance Rear Axles

Tough, durable Olds rearaxles provide the added margin of per-

formance for easy trailering. A higher axle ratio delivers more torque to the rear wheels for towing, or tough terrain. Rocket V-8 engines, however, develop high torque at relatively low rpm, so very high axle ratios are not required. (See axle ratio recommendations on preceding chart.)

Anti-Spin Rear Axle (G80) offers a limited-slip differential and provides surefooted traction in mud, snow, ice or gravel. Power is diverted from the spinning wheel to the wheel with the best traction. This option is recommended for all Oldsmobiles — except Toronado, which offers the superior traction of front-wheel drive.

Transmissions

Turbo Hydra-matic (M38) offers three-speed efficiency on Omega V-8s, and all Cutlasses and Vista-Cruisers. Turbo Hydra-matic (M40) is a three-speed fully automatic transmission standard on Delta 88, Delta 88 Royale, Custom Cruiser, Ninety-Eight and Toronado models. It is available on all Cutlass, Cutlass Supreme and Vista-Cruiser models with 455-cu.-inch engine.



Heavy-duty cooling is required for all medium- and heavy-weight towing. Not available for Omega.

Heavy-Duty Wheels (N99) are available on Cutlass, Cutlass S, Cutlass Supreme, Delta 88 and Ninety-Eight models. These wheels are standard equipment on Vista-Cruiser, Custom Cruiser and Toronado models. Not available for Omega.
