



TECHNOLOGICALLY SPEAKING, what places Subaru in a class by itself is the distinctively innovative, horizontally opposed Subaru Boxer engine, which is available in Baja models as either a powerful 210-hp intercooled and turbocharged 4-cylinder, or an energetic 165-hp naturally aspirated 4-cylinder. Rallyproven for exceptional reliability, it is unlike the more conventional engine layouts of other manufacturers in that its cylinders are aligned on a single, horizontal plane. The benefits of this unique design are many. For one, the compact size of the Subaru Boxer engine allows it to sit

Baja Turbo models are also equipped with our Electronic Throttle-Control (ETC) drive-by-wire technology for more accurate response. All told, the Subaru Boxer engine delivers

outstanding performance across a wide variety of driving conditions.






