

Uplander is a vehicle that can adapt to change effortlessly. The interior can be easily reconfigured to make room for whatever passes through the dual sliding side doors. That's thanks to the standard second-row flip-and-fold modular bucket seats and a removable 50/50 split 3rd-row rear seat. More usable space is provided by the Overhead Rail System that's standard on all but RWB LS. Versatility – with no gymnastics required.




For the convenience of rear-seat passengers, seatback storage compartments provide an ideal location to stow smaller items such as maps, magazines or wallets.

## **TECHNOLOGY**

MAKING THE SYSTEM WORK FOR YOU. Uplander incorporates a number of intelligent systems that contribute to its sure-footed handling. The variable valve timing on the new available 3.9L V6 VVT\* engine optimizes combustion timing to increase engine output. And the available on-demand Versatrak all-wheel-drive system only engages when front-wheel slippage is detected, optimizing traction in slippery conditions and fuel economy in normal conditions. With Uplander, the systems are on your side.




#### AUTOMATIC REAR LEVEL-CONTROL SUSPENSION

The rear level-control system automatically adjusts the ride height of the rear suspension to match the load, optimizing both handling characteristics and the aiming of the headlights. The system is available on LT2 and LT1 models.

#### FOUR-WHEEL DISC BRAKES

Every Uplander is equipped with large vented disc brakes at all four corners. Also standard is a fourwheel anti-lock braking system (ABS).



#### VERSATRAK ALL-WHEEL-DRIVE SYSTEM

The advanced on-demand Versatrak system shifts into AWD mode only when required – when front-wheel slippage is detected. By working on demand, the Versatrak system provides better fuel efficiency in normal conditions than full-time all-wheel-drive systems. Available on Uplander EWB LT2.

#### STABILITRAK STABILITY ENHANCEMENT SYSTEM

StabiliTrak applies brake pressure at the appropriate wheel or wheels to address the causes of understeer or oversteer. It responds in thousandths of a second when a lateral skid is detected, helping you maintain control and stay headed in your intended direction. Standard on FWD EWB models.

#### TRACTION CONTROL SYSTEM

The all-speed, full-function traction control system controls engine, transmission and brake functions, enhancing traction while accelerating on slippery surfaces. Available on FWD LT2 and LT1 models.

#### TWO V6 ENGINES

Uplander's standard 3.5L 3500 V6 engine generates 201 horsepower and 216 lb.-ft. of torque. The newly available 3.9L V6 engine with variable valve timing produces 240 horsepower. Both engines are mated with an electronically controlled four-speed automatic transmission.

#### AIR BAGS

Uplander features standard dual-stage frontal air bags.\*\*
This two-stage inflator system adjusts the deployment velocity of the air bags automatically, depending on the severity of the impact – lower-power at slower speeds of impact and higher-power if triggered by a higher-speed collision. Seat-mounted side-impact air bags are standard on LT2 and available on all other models.

#### REMOTE STARTING SYSTEM

The factory-installed remote vehicle start system enables you to start the engine from a distance of up to 60 m (200 ft.), simply by depressing a button on your key fob. The system is integrated with the factory-installed security system. Standard on LT2 and available on all other models.

# **TOWING**

Go ahead and fill all 3865 L (136.5 cu. ft.) of cargo space inside Uplander EWB models, or hook up a trailer to the hitch with the available Trailer Towing Package. It includes everything from a heavy-duty radiator and transmission oil

cooler to a wiring harness, and provides a towing capacity of up to 1588 kg (3500 lb.). That's a lot of capacity, and with the newly available 3.9L V6 VVT engine, you get even more torque – 240 lb.-ft. – to get it all moving.



### **SAFETY**

### YOU WON'T JUST FEEL SAFE.

With OnStar as standard equipment, you'll feel very safe and secure in an Uplander. And you'll be pleased to know that your peace of mind is very well founded: A rigid steel safety cage surrounds the passenger compartment. And for 2006, in addition to the standard dual-stage frontal air bags\* and seat-mounted side-impact air bags that are standard on LT2 models, Uplander offers available second-row side-impact air bags. So you can feel even safer.




