SPECIAL DE LUXE SPORT SEDAN

The interiors of all *Special De Luxe* models are truly distinguished. Extra inches of seat width, deeply cushioned seats, and high-quality upholstery fabrics give maximum passenger comfort and pleasure.



SPECIAL DE LUXE TOWN SEDAN

The spacious and inviting interior is made accessible by unusually wide doors. Concealed entrance steps with rubber treads promote convenience and safety.



FLEETLINE AEROSEDAN

This strikingly handsome new model, now offered by Chevrolet for the first time, besides being far advanced in styling, is exceptionally spacious and comfortable, seating six passengers in ease. Luggage space also is increased, being greater than in any other Chevrolet passenger car. Up-

holstery is finished in "Fleetweave" broadcloth. Scuff cover moldings on doors and seats are of bright metal. The low, racy appearance of the *Fleetline* Aerosedan is not an illusion; the roof curve is actually $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches lower than that of the 1942 *Special De Luxe* and *Master De Luxe* models.



SPECIAL DE LUXE FIVE-PASSENGER COUPE

The full-width rear seat, with arm rests, assures your passengers of full comfort. Every coupe model has a large luggage compartment under the rear deck, and a wide package ledge in the passenger compartment.



SPECIAL DE LUXE STATION WAGON

The interior is finished and trimmed to provide the utmost in comfort and convenience, in keeping with the passenger-car styling of the body exterior.

MASTER DE LUXE MODELS

The four *Master De Luxe* Chevrolets shown here are identical with the corresponding *Special De Luxe* models in chassis, engine, body structure, and seating arrangement. They differ from the *Special De Luxe* models chiefly in interior trim and equipment.

UNITIZED KNEE-ACTION

Chevrolet's Knee-Action represents the benefits of constant research, and of practical experience in the manufacture of 4,500,000 Knee-Action cars, beginning in 1934. Chevrolet alone has *unitized* Knee-Action—the entire front suspension (Knee-Action supports, arms, springs, shock absorbers, and even the front-wheel mountings, hubs and steering connections) being assembled as a single unit, adjusted and aligned in massive automatic machines, before being attached to the chassis frame. The result is Knee-Action at its best—and only Chevrolet has it.



SHOCKPROOF STEERING

True shockproof steering is inherent in the Chevrolet, because the unitized Knee-Action design maintains front-wheel alignment and eliminates wobble, thus doing away with the chief causes of steering-wheel jerk and vibration. Superior riding comfort results, as does also added safety, especially on difficult stretches of highway, on gravel or sandy roads, and on curves and turns.



HYDRAULIC BRAKES

Smooth, dependable braking, instantly responsive to the driver's control, is yours in a Chevrolet to an outstanding degree—because only Chevrolet possesses a braking system that combines the advantages of hydraulic actuation with the equally important advantages inherent in Chevrolet's exclusive design of brake-shoe linkage. This double-articulated linkage, by providing full contact of the shoes with the drums, prolongs brake-lining life and promotes positive brake action.



UNISTEEL BODIES BY FISHER

Chevrolet alone among the lowest-priced cars has the famous Body by Fisher, of Unisteel construction. The body is made of steel panels and has all-steel doors. The famous Turret Top is a single steel stamping,

as is also the floor, which extends in width to form the safety-steps as an integral part of the body structure. Not only safety, but also extraordinary durability, is achieved in the Chevrolet body, with its floor, panels, and roof welded to form a unit of tremendous strength.



INSTRUMENT PANEL



The instrument panel, finished in bright metal and plastics, is a masterpiece of design, combining beauty and utility. Note that even in this tiny illustration, numerals and indicators are easily readable. Speedometer and clock pointers are of a fluorescent plastic that transmits the glow of the instrument lights. (Clock furnished with *Special De Luxe* and *Fleetline* models only.)

LUGGAGE SPACE

Every Sedan and Coupe has a rear compartment, electrically lighted, of generously large capacity. The spare wheel is so mounted as to leave the maximum luggage space, and located so as to make its handling convenient.



ADJUSTABLE FRONT SEATS

Front seats are easily adjustable, to suit the stature of the driver. As the seat rolls forward, its height increases, so that a short driver's line of vision is raised to a level permitting a full view ahead.

NO DRAFT VENTILATION

Only Chevrolet, among low-priced cars, offers Fisher No Draft ventilation—a system that permits circulation of air exactly regulated to suit the weather conditions and to meet the desires of driver and passenger. The ventipanes, fitted with locks, are controlled by crank regulators.



VISION AND SAFETY GLASS

The wide, sloping windshield and the large expanse of glass in doors and windows provide maximum vision for the driver, who gets a full view ahead and to each side. Moreover, his vision is better because Chevrolet uses safety *plate* glass, free from the waviness common to safety sheet glass. Important aids to vision are standard equipment. Chevrolet furnishes two windshield wipers, mounted at the lower edge of the windshield so that they clear the widest area at eye level to provide wide-angle vision. Two defroster slots are provided, for use

with a car heater, to prevent steaming and frosting of the windshield. Sun visors may be turned to the side and also moved lengthwise, so that the sun's rays may be cut off from any direction.



TWO DOOR LOCKS

The car can be unlocked from either side. All doors may be locked without the use of a key. A glance at the locking buttons shows whether all doors are locked.






CONCEALED ENTRANCE STEPS

Wide safety-steps are concealed, and protected from snow and ice, by the flared bottom edge of the doors. In each front entrance step, at its forward end, is a convenient, self-cleaning foot scraper, by which one can easily remove snow or mud from one's shoes before entering the car.

The famous 90-horsepower Valve-in-Head Chevrolet engine is continued without a change in design, with the same massive crankshaft, heavy duty bearings, and lightweight cast-iron pistons—pistons developed and perfected by Chevrolet during its 20 years' experience with pistons of this same material. Superior performance and economy, plus unequalled durability, are built into every Chevrolet engine.

VALVE-IN-HEAD SIX—FAMOUS FOR ECONOMY

Wherever it is important to get every possible bit of power from an engine—as in military planes, racing boats, and speedway cars—the Valve-in-Head engine is used almost universally. The engineering reason is, simply, that a Valve-in-Head engine develops more power than an L-head engine of equal displacement and compression ratio. That is why the Chevrolet Valve-in-Head engine is so economical—it extracts more power from a given quantity of fuel than do other types, and therefore requires less fuel to accomplish any given task.

OCTANE SELECTOR PREVENTS POWER LOSS

Whatever grade of fuel you use, whether premium or low-cost, the Octane Selector adjusts the ignition timing to suit the fuel, and assures the maximum power and fuel economy possible.



PROVED CAST-IRON PISTONS

Chevrolet's lightweight cast-iron pistons represent the results of continued research and improvement based on Chevrolet's experience in making 80,000,000 cast-iron pistons in the last 20 years. Pistons in the 1942 models are identical, not only in material but in every detail of their design, with 8,000,000 pistons used in the 1941 models. A Chevrolet owner is assured of freedom from piston troubles, and of pistons that maintain peak performance and promote economy because they hold their close fit within the cylinders for extraordinarily long mileage.

FOUR-WAY LUBRICATION

Economy and long engine-life result from Chevrolet's specialized four-way lubrication. Each bearing or moving part is supplied with oil according to its special needs. This system uses:


- (1) Direct pressure to the crankshaft and camshaft.
- (2) Vapor spray to piston pins and cylinder walls.
- (3) Temperature-controlled metered pressure to the valve mechanism.
- (4) Super-pressure jets to the connecting rod bearings.

COMPLETE COOLING SYSTEM

Among the special features of Chevrolet's cooling system are:

- (1) Full-length water jacket.
- (2) Cylinder barrels completely surrounded by water.
- (3) Dual-outlet water pump, supplying both sides of the cylinder block.
- (4) Nozzle-cooling of exhaust valve seats.
- (5) Thermostatic control of water temperature.
- (6) Water passages between combustion chambers.


MASSIVE CRANKSHAFT, BUILT TO ENDURE



Rigid in itself, because of its massive design, the 63-pound crankshaft is made virtually vibrationless by its integral counterweights, a harmonic balancer, and accurate balancing of the shaft and flywheel as a unit. Four large bearings maintain alignment. Chevrolet's short-stroke design, and its light pistons, minimize unbalanced forces.



1942 CHEVROLET
CHASSIS FEATURES

Chevrolet has but one chassis, used in all models—*Fleetline, Special De Luxe, Master De Luxe*. Except for refinements in details and construction, the engine is identical with that used throughout 1941 production. The entire chassis is Chevrolet through and through, built of time-tested units developed to their highest efficiency. . . . The illustration on this page, with its color key, reveals many of the special chassis features that have made Chevrolet supreme. Note especially the simplicity and sturdiness of the Knee-Action front suspension, attached to the box-girder frame as a complete unit.
