Eagle Wagon.

The smart appearance of the Eagle Wagon belies its rugged 4WD character. Bright metal moldings, subtle pinstripes, white sidewall tires and styled wheel covers combine for a look of classic elegance. A spirited, electronically-controlled 4.2L six-cylinder engine, five-speed, floor-mount transmission, power steering and power brakes are standard conveniences any driver would appreciate. And the generous interior dimensions accommodate a family of six with ease.



Eagle Sedan.

This just might be the best touring car value in America. The proven Select Drive 2WD/4WD system lets you shift on the go to the drive mode you're comfortable with on any road in any season. Four doors open wide to accept up to six adults in the spacious, well appointed interior. A large trunk stores family quantities of luggage and gear. A 22 gallon capacity fuel tank permits considerable cruising range. Plus, Eagle Sedan just plain looks great going down the road...its classic styling set off by a vinyl padded formal roofline with opera glass windows. Flared wheel openings, white sidewall radial tires and a low silhouette provide sporty balance to the overall design.

Inside Eagle.

Knowing that Eagle is a rugged 4-wheel drive performer really makes it surprising when you first glimpse the inside. Everything you see and touch tells you that this is a luxury vehicle. Thick color-keyed carpet covers the floor (and cargo area in the wagon). Soft fabric covered visors and headliner help soak up sound. The split front seat with individually reclining seat backs and the full width rear bench seat are thickly padded and covered in your choice of Premium vinyl or handsome Highland Check in Blue, Garnet or Honey, depending on exterior color selection. The elegant Eagle Wagon Limited seats (shown left) are tailored in soft, supple, Honey leather. Instrumentation is well planned for read-at-a-glance convenience, and switches are positioned for fingertip control.

Eagle Wagon Limited.

The security and practicality of 4WD plus "first class" accommodations...that's Eagle Wagon Limited. This most elegant Eagle includes all of the thoughtful standards on the base wagon (page 6) plus supple leather upholstered seats, plush 18 oz. carpeting (12 oz. in the cargo area), a smart woodgrain steering wheel, a convenient parcel shelf, dual chrome, remotecontrol rearview mirrors, and wire wheel covers. Behind the rear bench seat there's a cavernous carpeted cargo area with skid strips and a retractable cargo area cover. It's accessible through a wide-opening, swing up rear hatch. For added flair, there's an optional Eagle Wagon Sport package including special black accenting and "4x4" graphics, steel-belted radials, halogen headlamps and fog lamps, black remote-control rearview sport mirror, and a leather-wrapped sport steering wheel.

HE TECHNOLOGY OF THE AMERICAN EAGLE

To be, or not to be...in 4-wheel drive. That's a question easily determined with a flick of the Select Drive switch on the Eagle instrument panel. Move the switch left to 2WD for normal traction when Eagle is traveling on smooth, dry road surfaces. Move the switch right when you need the extra security and traction provided when driving power is distributed to all four wheels. You may choose either drive mode even while traveling, at any speed, in any gear.

The Eagle Select Drive system is a derivative of the famous Jeep Selec-Trac, the best known automatic



2WD/4WD system in the world.

Select Drive is vastly different than the part time 4WD systems associated with off-road utility vehicles. It permits shifting on the go between 2WD and 4WD, and provides smooth, quiet, sure-footed performance in the 4WD mode for as long as you like without excessive wear on drive components.

E agle's pleasingly low silhouette is due in part to its independent front suspension system that also enhances Eagle riding comfort by permitting the front wheels to "step" over bumps individually.



With room for six, the convenience of four doors, a 4.2 liter engine and the stability of Select Drive 4-wheel drive. Eagle is the frequent choice of campers, sportsmen, snowmobilers and horsemen for trailering duty. Either the Eagle Wagon or Sedan can be equipped to handle up to Class II rated trailers (maximum of 3500 lbs. loaded trailer weight; 350 lbs. tongue weight).

LIGHT DUTY TRAILER PACKAGE for Class I trailers (up to 2000 lbs. loaded trailer; 200 lbs. tongue weight): includes bumper mounted hitch, fiveconnector wiring harness, and a vehicle-to-trailer wiring kit. Recommended equipment: automatic transmission, 3.08 axle ratio, heavy duty battery, automatic Load Leveler rear shock absorbers, and maximum duty cooling.

MEDIUM DUTY TRAILERING PACKAGE for Class II trailers (up to 3500 lbs. loaded trailer; 350 lbs. tongue weight): includes equalizing hitch, sevenconnector wiring harness, vehicle-to-trailer wiring kit, and auxiliary transmission oil cooler. Required equipment: automatic transmission, 3.08 axle ratio, heavy duty battery, automatic Load Leveler rear shock absorbers, and maximum duty cooling.

Eagle's 4.2L six-cylinder engine has built-in intelligence. Sophisticated electronics monitor and control a variety of engine functions for improved engine efficiency and lower emissions.
