



All 1973 Dodges offer major chassis and interior improvements to reduce interior noise levels. What's more, Charger and Coronet offer Dodge's famous Torsion-Quiet Ride. Until now only available on our full-sized Monaco/Polara series. This is a sophisticated suspension system which helps isolate the passenger compartment from road and engine noises through the use of strategically located rubber mounts, extra padding, and insulation materials. Charger SE goes a step further with a premium silencing package that indeed makes it a super quiet car.



New Electronic Security Alarm System for Monaco and Polara.

An Electronic Security Alarm System is optional on all '73 Monacos and Polaras. When a violation of hood, doors, or trunk lid occurs, headlights, tail-lights, and side marker lights flash in conjunction with a pulsing of the horn. The alarm continues as long as the violation exists or until shut off with the ignition-door key. It then rearms itself automatically. The system is camouflaged and is built into your car's regular wiring system to thwart tampering.





New Electronic Ignition System Standard Equipment

Proved in a million miles of street and highway driving, this revolutionary new system offers many advantages over conventional ignition systems. Faster starts in the hottest or coldest weather, no points or condenser to replace come tune-up time, engine emissions greatly reduced and misfires at highway speeds virtually a thing of the past make the new Electronic Ignition System a real step forward...it's practically maintenance-free. 


New High-Speed Starter Motor

Dodge full-size wagons combine the smooth driving and handling of a full-size car with living-room comfort. Take a look at the standard features on Monaco, Polara Custom and Polara. TorqueFlite automatic transmission, power steering, power front disc brakes, heating/defrosting with upper level ventilation, Torsion-Quiet Ride, power tailgate window, three-way tailgate, a special rear air deflector that helps keep the rear window free from road dust, and Chrysler's revolutionary Electronic Ignition System. For safety when you're driving with children in three-seat models, there's an "Auto-Lock" system that automatically locks the rear door when the ignition is on. Durable and beautiful vinyl bench seats are standard.

You'll find more than ample power in the Polara, Polara Custom and Monaco Wagons. The big 360 cid V8 is standard. All three are on a 122" wheelbase. Monaco and Polara Custom come in 2-seat and 3-seat versions.

How about options to suit your particular needs? They include a roof luggage rack, power seats, power windows, and Air Temp air conditioning, AM/FM radio, cargo deck carpeting, the Security Alarm System, a Trailer Towing Package and more!

Dodge's mid-size wagons give you big performance and comfort. A host of model, engine and option choices let you tailor your wagon to your exact needs. All models feature unitized body construction, Torsion-Quiet Ride and power front disc brakes. The standard engine on all the Coronet wagons is a peppy 318 cid V8 and comes equipped with the new Electronic Ignition System. All come on a trim, stable 118" wheelbase. Coronet Crestwood is a truly luxurious wagon, combining rich wood grained styling outside, a beautiful and practical interior, with cargo deck carpeting, rugged engineering and big roominess. Coronet and Coronet Custom are ideal for economy operation with a flair. On three-seat wagons, the special Auto-Lock Tailgate is standard. 

Illustrated at the lower left is the standard seating on the Crestwood. All-vinyl with a pull down centre armrest. Features include a threeway tailgate and the cargo capacity to take a 4' x 8' sheet of plywood flat on the floor.



1973. The Solid Difference in Dodge Design and Engineering.

Listed on this page are examples of the many Dodge innovations, systems, and testing procedures that make your 1973 Dodge the best Dodge ever built. In many areas, such as sound control and emission control systems, Dodge is thinking of you when it comes to automobile performance and safety. Dodge is not only interested in the satisfaction of its customers, but also in the total environment. Comprehensive engine and transmission tests provide additional insurance that your new Dodge is in top shape when you get it, and stays that way. All in all, Dodge design and engineering represents a solid difference you can see and feel.

Electronic Ignition System

No points to wear out, no condenser to replace. The cost of tune-ups drops considerably, engine emissions are reduced, and engine misfirings at highway speeds are virtually eliminated. It's practically maintenance-free, and if something should go wrong, an electronic testing device lets your Dodge Distributor pinpoint the problem and fix it quickly.

Wiring Harness Test System

Use of an automatic test system makes possible 100 percent checkout of all wiring circuits during assembly. Exterior lamps, heater motor, power windows, rear defogger and windshield wipers and more are all checked for possible line loads or short circuits. You can depend on Dodge.

Transmission Test Computer System

The heart of this system is a Process Automatic Computer. Coupled with manual testing techniques prior to assembly of the transmission into vehicles, the system is capable of subjecting 28 transmissions at one time to the most rigorous testing program. The program, together with regular highway tests, was developed to ensure smooth, efficient transmission operation.

Emission Control Features

Electric Assist Choke—All 1973 engines are equipped with an electric assist choke to help reduce emissions during starting and warm-up. The assist choke shortens the period of choke operation when outside temperatures are above about 68°F, thereby cutting down on emissions.

Exhaust Gas Recirculation System—This system, standard on all Dodge models, introduces controlled amounts of exhaust gases into the incoming fuel/air mixture. These recirculated gases serve to lower peak burning temperatures and thereby control the formation of oxides of nitrogen.

Safety and Extra Protection Features

Stronger Bumpers—All 1973 Chryslerbuilt cars are equipped with extra protection bumper systems. The bumpers can withstand barrier impact forces of 5 mph on the front and 2½ mph on the rear with no significant damage to body or chassis components, including the lights or to the bumper system itself.

The supporting members for front bumpers nave been strengthened to distribute the force over a wider area and thus lessen the probability of damage. All bumpers are equipped with large 3-4 inch thick solid-rubber guards that can be compressed up to 60 percent.

Fire Retardant Materials—All seat cushions, seat backs, seat belts, head-lining, armrests, compartment shelves, head restraints, floor coverings, and trim panels in 1973 Dodge models are made of fire retardant materials. In an emergency, these chemicals provide passengers with added protection by retarding both combustion and the fumes given off by combustion.

84 Decibel Sound Level—For 1973, all models have operating sound level no greater than 84 decibels at wide-open-throttle. This has been achieved primarily through modifications to exhaust and air intake systems. This level makes your new Dodge quieter both inside and out.
